SEPTEMBER 25th LANCELOT ANDREWES, BISHOP AND SCHOLAR. Lancelot Andrewes (1555-25 September 1626) was an English Bishop and scholar, during the reigns of Elizabeth I and James I. During the latter's reign, he oversaw the translation of the Authorized (or King James) version of the Bible.
