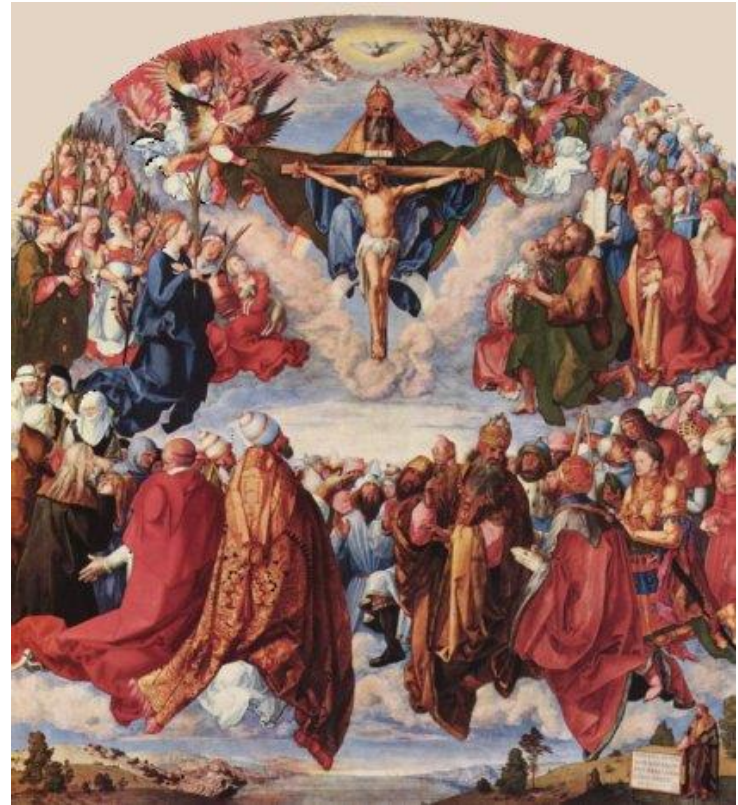

**CORPUS CHRISTI, Next Sunday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7.00 p.m.  
Evensong and Benediction.**

Celebrates the presence of the Body and Blood, of Jesus in the elements of the Eucharist.

Two months earlier, the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper is observed on Maundy Thursday in a sombre atmosphere leading to Good Friday.

The liturgy on Maundy Thursday also commemorates

Christ's washing of the disciples' feet

and the agony in the Garden of Gethsemane.

The feast of Corpus Christi is focused solely on the joy of the gift of the Eucharist.

*from* **The Crown of the Year** *by Austin Farrer, weekly paragraphs on the Holy Sacrament.* The disciples who were present at the Supper saw and heard Jesus Christ making eucharist to the Father over the bread and the cup. They were witnesses of the intercourse between the Eternal Son and his Eternal Father. Mortal ears and eyes at that moment perceived the movement of speech and love which passes in the heart of the Godhead; human minds entered into that converse of the Divine Persons which is the life and happiness of the Blessed Trinity. Belief in the Trinity is not a distant speculation; the Trinity is that blessed family into which we are adopted. God has asked us into his house, he has spread his table before us, he has set out bread and wine. We are made one body with the Son of God, and in him converse with the Eternal Father, through the indwelling of the Holy Ghost.
